

Episode # 1-03 Jesus is Jehovah

I. The “Knowing God in the Word Radio Program” is for the purpose of helping listeners to fulfill the greatest need we have as believers – to know God.

II. The way to please God is through faith. But what is it we need to have faith in?

III. Faith versus works...what work is it God wants? John 6:28. What are the works of God? V.29. Jesus answered with THE WORK of God...believing in Himself.

IV. But Who is the Lord Jesus Christ?

A. Who is the Savior?

1. Titus 1:3. God is our Savior. Titus 1:4. Lord Jesus Christ is our Savior.
2. Titus 2:10. God is our Savior. Titus 2:13. Jesus Christ is our Savior.
3. Titus 3:4. God is our Savior. Titus 3:6. Jesus Christ is our Savior.
4. Are there two Saviors? Are there two sources of salvation?
5. Isaiah 43:11. There is no Savior besides the LORD Jehovah/Yahweh.
6. If there is no Savior but Jehovah, and if God is our Savior, and Jesus Christ is our Savior, then Who is Jesus Christ? He must be both God and Jehovah.

B. Isaiah saw the glory.

1. Isaiah 6:1-5. Isaiah saw a superlative vision of Jehovah.
2. John 12:41. Verse 40 quotes Isaiah 6:10. John claims Isaiah saw Jesus' glory. But Isaiah says he saw Jehovah's glory. Jesus must be Jehovah!

C. John the Baptizer prepared the way for Whom?

1. Isaiah 40:3. A prophecy of one who would prepare the way of Jehovah.
2. John 1:23. John applies this to himself preparing the way for Jesus Christ! Also Matthew 3:3.

D. Who is the Creator?

1. Isaiah 42:5,8. He created the heavens and the earth.
2. John 1:3. The Word Who became flesh made all things.

E. Who is the first and the last?

1. Isaiah 44:6. Jehovah is the First and the Last.
2. Revelation 1:11. The First and the Last. V.12-13. John turned and saw One like the Son of Man. 17-18. Jesus Christ is the First and the Last.

F. Who is it Whom all will ultimately worship?

1. Isaiah 45:18, He swears...verse 23, all knees will bow and tongues swear to Him, Jehovah.
2. Philippians 2:9-11. Every knee will bow to Jesus and every tongue confess that He is Lord. What does this mean? That He is Jehovah!

V. There can be no doubt. The God we must believe in is the Lord Jesus Christ.

A. John 20:30-31. We need to believe in Who Jesus is.

B. I Corinthians 15:1-4. We need to believe in what Christ did.

VI. To enter into relationship with God, the thing we need to have is faith. That faith revolves around Jesus Christ. May all who hear believe in the record God has given us of His Son!
